## How to calculate GPA

Sum result of (Grade point for each course * Credit hours of each course) / Total Credit hours

## For Example:

| Letter Grade | Credit Hours | Course Code |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| A | 2 | LAW106 |
| A | 3 | LAW111 |
| C + | 3 | LAW191 |
| B | 3 | LAW121 |

## Calculate the GPA as the following:

$\left((2 * 4)+(3 * 4)+\left(3^{*} 2\right)+\left(3^{*} 2.33\right)+(3 * 3)\right) / 14=2.99$

- Use the same way to calculate Cumulative GPA, but for all courses
- Only graded hours that are included in GPA or cumulative GPA
