The KU library has subscribed to Art and Architecture Complete database which includes full-text coverage of more than 370 periodicals with content coverage dating back to 1937 and additional full-text for more than 220 books. It also includes cover-to-cover indexing and abstracts for more than 770 academic journals, magazines and trade publications, as well as for nearly 230 books. Uniquely, Art & Architecture Complete contains selective coverage for over 60 additional publications, and an image collection of over 63,000 images provided by Picture Desk and others.
