Machlatkom Alena CECE Event



Project Idea

This innovative project is acceptable for its simplicity and for keeping taste in both form and content. A corn version with a different set of innovative flavors and some other additions, and each flavor was released to match its distinctive taste.

Talk to us about how you got involved in the project.

Initially, it was an idea that came to light about six years ago in 2017 and was limited to family, friends, and acquaintances. It was held at Kingdom University and was well received and accepted. It motivates us to participate more.

What were the challenges you faced?



Firstly, making a decision to start the project, and I am still a university student. What is your advice that you would give to **Bahraini youth to open their businesses?**




The President of Kingdom University receives MP Abdullah Al-Rumaihi
