5. How to control the implementation of the general budget.



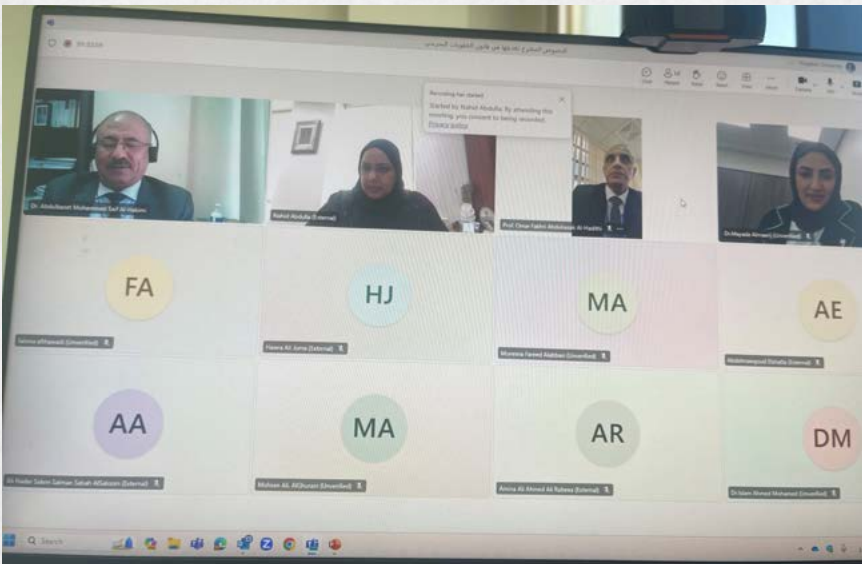
Light and Charter Event

Second course for lecturer preparation

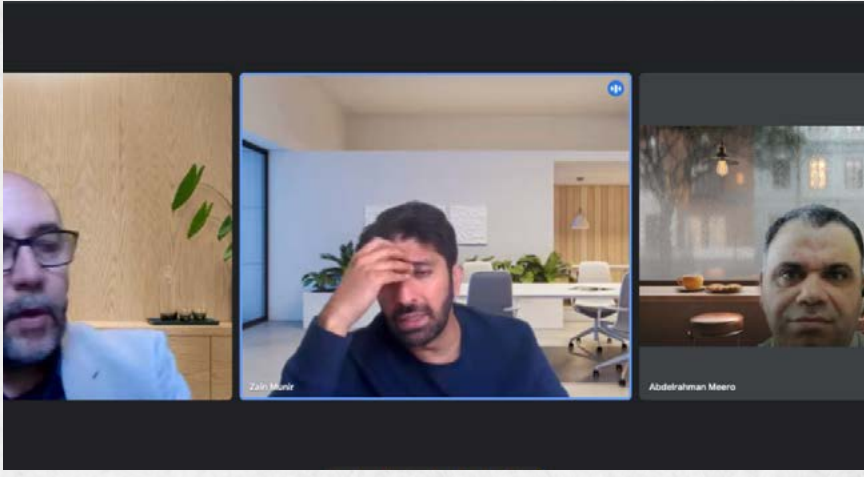

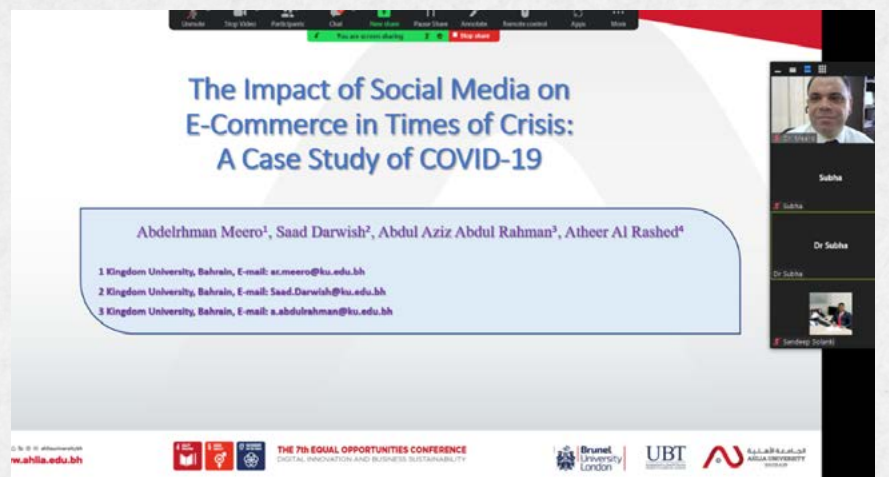
In-Service Lecture to Start a Semester : «Mastering Emotional Intelligence: Focus on Anger and Stress Management» Date: February 2024 ,7

Community Engagement participated and sponsored by Dr. Venus Bunagan “Bahrain Youth Basketball Tournament-Season 2”

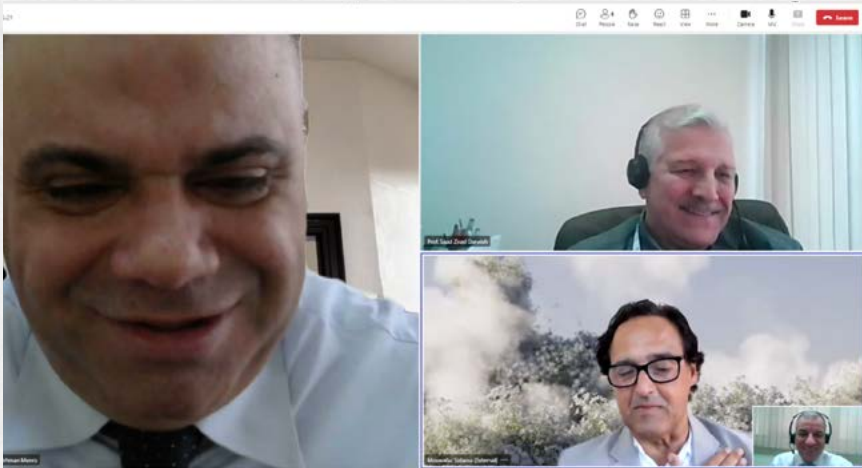
