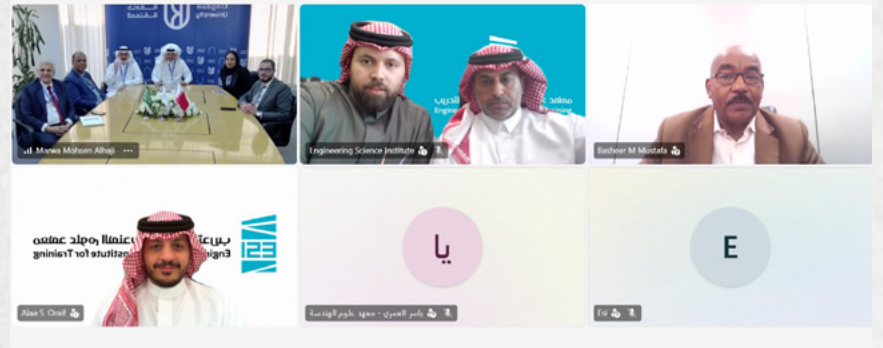


## Kingdom University Signs MoU with Engineering Science Institute for Training on 24th February 2026
