The visit also highlighted the University’s commitment to maintaining an organized and supportive examination environment and ensuring the smooth conduct of examinations.

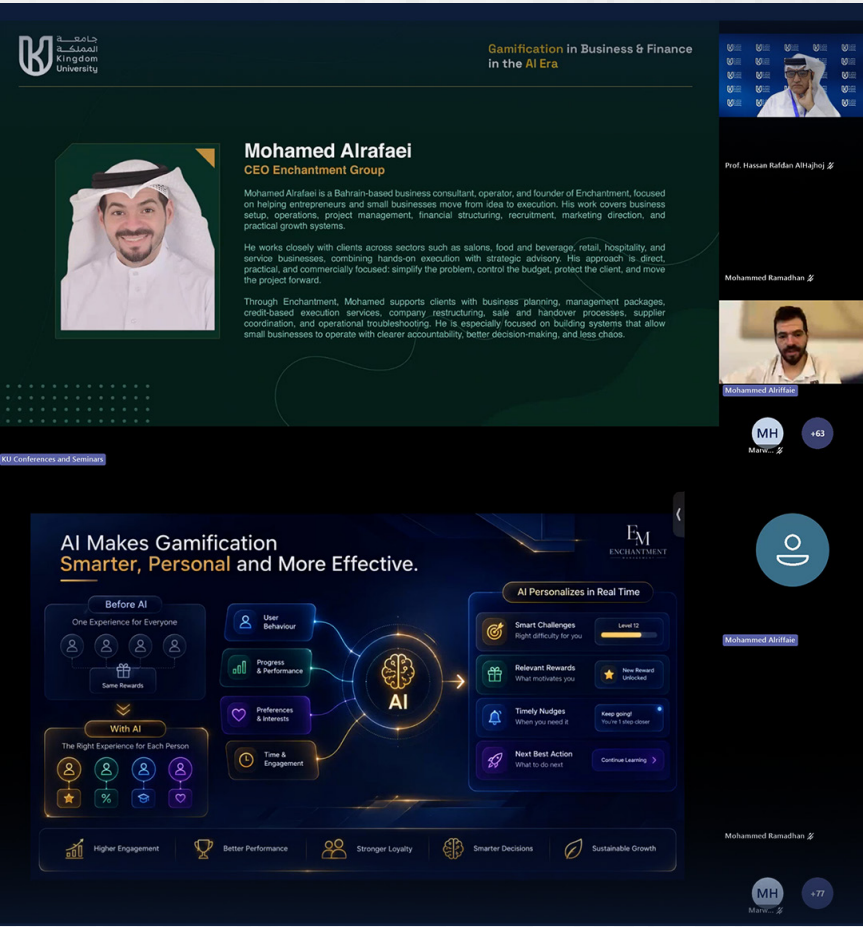


End of Academic Year 2026-2025 Staff Gathering

# KU Explores the Future of Business Innovation Through Seminar on Gamification and AI



Bahrain, July 19th, 2026 – KU successfully hosted an online seminar entitled “Gamification in Business&Finance in the AI Era,”highlighting the growing impact of gamification and artificial intelligence on modern business practices and financial services. Held via Microsoft Teams, the event was organized by the College of Business Administration in collaboration with the AI Research Center, Community Engagement Department, and the Continuing Education Unit. The seminar attracted students, academics, and professionals interested in the latest developments in digital transformation and innovation. The event commenced with opening remarks delivered by H.E.
